# Regional Parks

## **BLACK DIAMOND MINES Regional Preserve**

On Somersville Road, two miles south of James Donlon Blvd. near Antioch  
757-2620

Black Diamond Mines is a 3,650-acre preserve with a fascinating history. It was the largest operation of its kind in California, from 1860 to the turn of the century, when coal mining was a booming business in the Black Diamond Region. Thirty-four miles of trails wonder through the hills covered with wildflowers, almond, black locust, eucalyptus and pepper trees. The area is home to over 100 species of bird. Interpretive programs on the cultural history are available. Tours of the Underground Mining Museum are temporarily discontinued while the mines undergo repairs.

## **BRIONES Regional Park**

A tranquil 5,434 acre wilderness of rolling hills and shaded canyons. More than twenty miles of trails make Briones a wonderful place for hiking, jogging and horseback riding. Additionally, there is an archery range and picnic areas at both entrances.

## **CARQUINEZ SHORELINE Regional Park**

The recently created 8,576-acre park has more than 12 miles of trails with spectacular views of the Delta. Hikers can access the historic California Hiking and riding trail, which connects with a

network of trails that traverse the county.

**LAFAYETTE RESERVOIR  
Recreation Area**

Located at the west end of Lafayette at Mt. Diablo Blvd. and Entrance Road  
284-9669

The reservoir and 850-acre recreation area offers hiking, fishing, boating and picnicking. The reservoir is stocked with trout and has several small fishing piers, as well as rowboat and pedal boat rentals. A boat ramp provides launching for visitor's private sailboats and fishing boats. The reservoir is surrounded by more than eight miles of trails. Visitors may stroll around the reservoir along the three-mile paved trail that follows the shoreline. The Visitor's Center is open daily and offers exhibits and information.

**LAS TRAMPAS Regional  
Wilderness**

Located on Bollinger Canyon Road off Crow Canyon Road, west of Danville

Las Trampas is an ideal place for hiking and horseback riding, with

more than 3,558 acres of hills and canyons. More than thirty miles of trails wind through the hills and oak groves, often affording magnificent views. There is a picnic area and a group campground available by reservation. Las Trampas Stables offers horse rentals.

**MARTINEZ Regional Shoreline**

In Martinez, on North Court Street near Ferry Street

Along the Carquinez Strait, it is a two-mile-long, 343-acre natural waterfront, with a sandy beach, a pond and saltwater marshes. Along with considerable open space, there is a fishing pier, a marina, a restaurant, picnic areas, a playground, and hiking trails. Additional facilities include a soccer field, baseball fields, an exercise area, a horse arena, boce ball courts and a bicycle motocross racing course.

**MORGAN TERRITORY

# Driver Information

## **Driver's License**

You are required by California law to obtain California driver's license within 10 days of establishing residence. You should try to get it as soon as possible, as it is constantly utilized as identification.

To obtain a license, you must complete the following:

1. Written test on the rules of the road (mandatory)
2. Eye test (mandatory)
3. Driving test (only if you do not have a valid license in another state or if your license has been revoked or has been expired for one year)

## **Automobile Registration**

If you are moving from out of state, you must register your out of state vehicle upon entry. To avoid penalty, you have 20 days to resolve this matter.

### **Registration costs include:**

1. Registration fee
2. License plate charge
3. Sales Tax, if car is purchased within the last 90 days.

### **When registering your out-of-state vehicle, you must have:**

1. California smog certificate
2. Out of state title and registration
3. The vehicle you are registering.

The registration fee depends on the make and year of the car. In general, newer

cars and more expensive cars will cost more to register.

## **Smog Certificates**

All cars that you plan to register in California (that are newer than either 1955 for domestic or 1965 for foreign models) must have a smog certificate prior to registration, even if no additional smog device is necessary. Certification charges will vary. A smog inspection can be completed at many convenient locations. You may want to check with a nearby service station or dealer for details.

## **Child Safety Seats**

Effective January 1, 1983, California law requires children younger than four years or weighing less than 40 pounds to be secured in seats meeting federal safety standards.

## **Seat Belt Law**

Effective January 1, 1986, California Law requires the driver and all passengers in a passenger vehicle to wear seat belts.

## **Insurance**

Automobile insurance is *required* and must provide a *minimum* coverage as follows:

1. \$15,000 personal injury (or death) for one person
2. \$30,000 for multiple injuries (or deaths)
3. \$ 5,000 for property damage
